**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act to reimburse the George L. Darey Inland Fisheries and Game Fund.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 11 of chapter 131 of the general laws is hereby amended by adding the following
2 sentence to the end of the section:-

3 The George L. Darey inland fisheries and game fund shall be reimbursed annually from
4 the general fund for all loss of revenue for any fishing or hunting license provided at a discount
5 and for any license provided free of charge.
