- contrary, the Division of Health Care Finance and Policy is hereby directed and authorized to
   conduct a comprehensive study to investigate disparities in the provision of health care coverage
- 4 to individuals and/or their spouses when there is a change in marital status. Said study shall
- 5 include, but not be limited to, the identification and review of said disparities in both insured and
- 6 self-insured plans, as well as recommendations for alleviating disparities. The Division shall
- 7 provide an opportunity for interested parties to submit relevant testimony. The Division shall
- 8 file a report of its study, including recommendations and drafts of any legislation, if necessary,
- 9 with the clerks of the Senate and House of Representatives within one year of the effective date
- 10 of this act.
