An Act relative to insurance surcharges and inspection stickers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 113B of chapter 175 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 216, at the end thereof, the following sentence:-  
3 "Driving a motor vehicle which has an expired inspection sticker shall not be considered a  
4 surchargeable incident."
