### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act providing financial relief to long term care facilities required to obtain criminal offender record information for potential employees.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 172E of chapter 6 of the General Laws as most recently amended
- 2 by section 25 of chapter 256 of the acts of 2010, is hereby further amended by adding thereto the
- 3 following last sentence: A long term care facility seeking criminal offender record information
- 4 shall only be charged one fee assessable under section 172A for any individual, notwithstanding
- 5 that (a) the individual may have had more than one last name (for example maiden name and
- 6 married name) or (b) more than one request for criminal offender record information is submitted
- 7 by the long term care facility for each last name used by the individual.
