In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to vacated foreclosed residential property.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1: Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the
- 2 contrary, a creditor shall place residential properties back on the market for sale or lease within
- 3 one calendar year of foreclosure. Failure to place such residential properties back on the market
- 4 for sale or lease within one calendar year of foreclosure shall result in forfeiture of property to
- 5 the town or city in which the residential property is located.
