Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 37 of Chapter 129 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020

2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the fourth sentence the following

4 Such fines shall not revert to the General Fund and shall instead be deposited in the

5 Homeless Animal Prevention and Care Fund, as established by section 35ww of chapter 10 of

6 General Laws, and shall be available for use in subsequent fiscal years.
