Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 32D of Chapter 140 of the General Laws as so appearing is

2 hereby amended by inserting after the first paragraph the following new paragraph:--

3 Violations of this section shall be met with a fee to be determined by the manufactured housing

4 commission.

5 SECTION 2. Section 32G of Chapter 140 of the General Laws as so appearing is

6 hereby amended by striking out, in line 43, the words "ten nor more than one hundred" and

7 inserting in place thereof the following:--

8 50 nor more than 200
