In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act to study disparities in health care resulting from changes in marital status.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the 2 contrary, the Center for Health Information and Analysis is hereby directed and authorized to 3 conduct a comprehensive study to investigate disparities in the provision of health care coverage 4 to individuals and/or their spouses when there is a change in marital status. Said study shall 5 include, but not be limited to, the identification and review of said disparities in both insured and 6 self-insured plans, as well as recommendations for alleviating disparities. The Center shall 7 provide an opportunity for interested parties to submit relevant testimony. The Center shall file a 8 report of its study, including recommendations and drafts of any legislation, if necessary, with 9 the clerks of the Senate and House of Representatives within one year of the effective date of this 10 act.
