An Act relative to group insurance commission procurement.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Paragraph Twenty Sixth (h) of Section 7 of Chapter 4 of the General Laws,
- 2 as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, after the word
- 3 "person;" the following words:- except that this subparagraph shall not apply to proposals and
- 4 bids as described herein as made or received by the group insurance commission.
- 5 SECTION 2. Section 7 of Chapter 4 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020
- 6 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 194, after the word "person;" the
- 7 following words:- except that this subparagraph shall not apply to proposals and bids as
- 8 described herein as made or received by the group insurance commission.
