In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to coverage for chronic illness.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 84 of Chapter 58 of the Acts of 2006 is amended by inserting after subsection (d) the following new subsection:-
- 3 (e), notwithstanding any General or Special Law no carrier shall be permitted to charge a
- 4 co-payment or deductible for any prescriptions or devices that are prescribed by a physician that
- 5 are necessary for the treatment or maintenance of a chronic disease, illness or condition. The
- 6 department of public health shall adopt regulations further defining a chronic disease, illness or
- 7 condition.
