An Act providing Medicaid coverage for tobacco cessation programs.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 118E of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting at the end of section  
2 10M the following:-

3 “provided further that “tobacco use cessation counseling” shall include individual, group  
4 and phone counseling by a physician, dentist, behavioral health counselor, mental health  
5 counselor, certified tobacco use cessation counselor, or other qualified clinician.”
