#### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act to expand intensive parole supervision.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter twenty-seven of the general laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding after section five the following new section:-
- 3 Section 5A. The Parole Board shall establish in each region of the Commonwealth an
- 4 intensive parole for sex offenders program. Such program shall be modeled upon the current
- 5 program operated by the parole board in Middlesex County, and shall include unannounced
- 6 visits, counseling, electronic monitoring, random drug testing, polygraph testing and other
- 7 aspects of intensive supervision.
