In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act to clarify the venue of prosecution for larceny by check.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 277 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting after section 62C the following section:-
- 3 Section 62D. The crime set forth in section 37 of chapter 266 may be prosecuted and
- 4 punished in any judicial district where the check, draft or order for the payment of money was
- 5 executed or delivered, or where the money or property or services obtained thereby were
- 6 delivered.
