Senate, – Pursuant to the provisions of Senate Rule 19, the committee on Ways and Means reports the following bill: An Act relative to unemployment insurance rates (Senate, No. 8).

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to unemployment insurance rates.

Whereas, the deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is forthwith to lower the cost of unemployment insurance, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 14 of chapter 151A of the General Laws, the
- 2 experience rate of an employer qualifying therefor under subsection (b) of said section 14 of said
- 3 chapter 151A shall be the rate which appears in column "E" in clause (1) of subsection (i) of said
- 4 section 14 of said chapter 151A for calendar year 2011.
- 5 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of January 1, 2011.
