## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to the issuance of liquor licenses.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 12 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “law”, in line 107 the following  
3 sentence:-     No license shall be issued to any applicant who has been previously convicted of  
4 violating section 24G or section 24L of chapter 90 or section 13 1/2 of chapter 265 by a court of  
5 the commonwealth or another jurisdiction because of a like offense or previously convicted of a  
6 second or subsequent conviction of paragraph (a) of subdivision (1) of section 24 of said chapter  
7 90 by a court of the commonwealth or another jurisdiction because of a like offense.
