An Act relative to electronic signatures for electronic applications for criminal complaints.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 22 of Chapter 276 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “subscribed”, in line 4, the  
3 words:- , electronically or in person...

4 SECTION 2. Section 22 of Chapter 276 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
5 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 7, the following words after the word  
6 “Procedure.”:- If a complaint is subscribed to electronically by the complainant, the complainant,  
7 if a law enforcement officer, may, in lieu of being examined on oath by a justice, subscribe to the  
8 complaint under the pains and penalties of perjury.

9 SECTION 3. Section 2 of Chapter 275 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
10 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “subscribed”, in line 5, the  
11 words:- , electronically or in person...
