An Act relative to divorce.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 31 of chapter 208 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-
- In divorce, separation, or 209A proceedings involving children and a marital home, the
- 4 party remaining in the home shall not conduct a dating or sexual relationship within the home
- 5 until a divorce is final and all financial and custody issues are resolved, unless the express
- 6 permission is granted by the courts.
