# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act to update Chapter 40B to support the creation of affordable housing while strengthening local oversight.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	There shall be a commission to explore opportunities for reforming and improving
2	regional planning pursuant to chapter 40B of the General Laws. The commission shall submit a
3	report to the house and senate clerks and the chairs of the joint committee on housing offering
4	recommendations for increasing the sustainable supply of affordable housing in our communities
5	while also increasing the authority of local communities to manage the siting and design of these
6	projects so as to avoid undue harm to neighborhoods, schools, the environment, traffic and other
7	local concerns.

8 The commission shall consist of the following 11 members: the secretary of the
9 department of housing and community development or a designee who shall serve as chair of the

- 10 commission; 4 members appointed by the governor; 2 members appointed by the senate
- 11 president; 1 member appointed by the minority leader of the senate; 2 members appointed by the
- 12 speaker of the house; and 1 member appointed by the minority leader of the house of
- 13 representatives.
- 14 The commission shall submit its report no later than June 30, 2022.
