**In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen**

An Act regulating the use of buprenorphine in opioid dependence treatment.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1: Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the department  
2 of public health shall promulgate regulations relative to the use of buprenorphine and its variants  
3 in the treatment of opioid dependence. Said regulations shall include, but not be limited to:  
4 requiring prescribing entities to conduct routine toxicology screens of clients, pill call-backs,  
5 maximum take-home dosages, and any other regulations deemed necessary to limit diversion of  
6 buprenorphine and its variants.
