- SECTION 1. Section 36 of Chapter 152 of the General Laws, appearing in the 2000
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 74 to 76, inclusive, the following
- 3 sentence:-
- 4 No amount shall be payable under this section for disfigurement that is purely scar based,
- 5 unless such disfigurement is on the face, neck or hands.
