An Act regarding juvenile adjudications.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 10(d) of chapter 269 of the 2018 Official Edition of the General

- 6 a juvenile.
