**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court

An Act relative to seasonal employment.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 151 of the General Laws, section 1A, is hereby amended by striking out  
2 paragraph number (20), as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, and inserting in place thereof  
3 the following subsection:-

4 (20) in an amusement park of a permanent or traveling nature, containing an aggregation  
5 of amusement devices, games, shows, and other attractions, licensed pursuant to Chapter 140,  
6 Section 205A, and operated for public use, recreation or amusement during a period, or  
7 accumulated periods, not in excess of one hundred seventy days in any one year.
