An Act ensuring fair housing for homeless families.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 30 of chapter 23B of the General Laws, as amended by section 120 of chapter 7
- 2 of the acts of 2023, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence after the first
- 3 paragraph:- Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the
- 4 emergency housing assistance program established herein shall be available only to residents of
- 5 the commonwealth who have resided in the commonwealth for at least 1 year.
