**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act relative to prevention of EBT fraud.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 27A of chapter 18 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking the word “designate.” and inserting in place
3 thereof the following:- “designate; provided that, every sixth check must be collected at the
4 recipient’s local branch office. The recipient shall be required to present a photo identification to
5 receive said check.”
