## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to children's mental health clinicians..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 22 of chapter 32A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
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2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "setting", in line 85, the

3 following words: - "and, for persons under the age of 19, shall include collateral services"

- SECTION 2. Subsection (i) of said section 22 of said chapter 32A, as so appearing, is
  hereby amended by striking out the last paragraph.
- 6 SECTION 3. Said section 22 of said chapter 32A, as so appearing, is hereby amended 7 by adding the following subsection:—
