AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "and Stone" and substitute "<u>Stone,</u> <u>Glassman, Kittleman, Klausmeier, Mathias, Middleton, and Ramirez</u>"; in line 2, after "Duties" insert "<u>and Membership</u>"; strike beginning with "study" in line 4 down through "use" in line 5 and substitute "<u>work, in a certain manner, to develop certain</u> <u>strategies to enable organizations that adopt telemedicine to practice certain</u> <u>techniques for a certain purpose; altering the membership of the Commission;</u> <u>requiring that, to the extent practicable, certain members of the Commission</u> <u>reasonably reflect the geographic, racial, ethnic, cultural, and gender diversity of the</u> <u>State</u>"; and in line 6, strike "duties of the".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 14, strike "and"; after line 14, insert:

"(IX) THE CHAIR OF THE MARYLAND HEALTH CARE COMMISSION, OR THE CHAIR'S DESIGNEE; AND";

in line 15, strike "(ix)" and substitute "(X)"; after line 27, insert:

"(2) <u>TO THE EXTENT PRACTICABLE, THE MEMBERS APPOINTED BY</u> <u>THE GOVERNOR SHALL REASONABLY REFLECT THE GEOGRAPHIC, RACIAL,</u> <u>ETHNIC, CULTURAL, AND GENDER DIVERSITY OF THE STATE.</u>";

and in line 28, strike "(2)" and substitute "(3)".

On page 5, strike beginning with "STUDY" in line 1 down through "APPROPRIATE" in line 9 and substitute "WORK, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE SB0249/707573/1 Amendments to SB 249 Page 2 of 2
