House Bill 976

(Prince George's County Delegation)

Environmental Matters

Prince George's County - State's Attorney - Salary PG 310-14

This bill increases the salary of the Prince George's County State's Attorney. The bill establishes that the annual salary is (1) \$195,000 for calendar 2015; (2) \$201,250 for calendar 2016; (3) \$207,500 for calendar 2017; (4) \$213,750 for calendar 2018; and (5) \$220,000 for calendar 2019 and each subsequent year.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Prince George's County expenditures increase by \$29,300 in FY 2015 and by a minimum of \$62,700 annually thereafter; by FY 2020, expenditures increase by \$91,200 annually. Local revenues are not affected.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: The State's Attorney for Prince George's County receives an annual salary of \$150,000. **Exhibit 1** shows the salary for the State's Attorney in each county based on fiscal 2014 data (where available), as provided by the Maryland Association of Counties.

Article III, § 35 of the Maryland Constitution prohibits the salary or compensation of any public officer from being increased or diminished during the individual's term of office, except those whose full term is fixed by law in excess of four years.

Local Fiscal Effect: County expenditures increase by approximately \$29,300 in fiscal 2015 and by \$62,700 in fiscal 2016. By fiscal 2020, when the salary increases are fully implemented, county expenditures increase by \$91,200 annually. The estimate includes fringe benefits.
