## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Department of Transportation – Modal Administrations – Appointments**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring that the appointment of the administrator or executive  
4 director of certain modal administrations in the Department of Transportation be  
5 subject to the advice and consent of the Senate; and generally relating to the  
6 appointment of the administrators and executive directors of modal administrations  
7 of the Department.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,  
9 Article – Transportation  
10 Section 5–201(a), 5–202, 6–201(a), 6–202, and 7–201  
11 Annotated Code of Maryland  
12 (2015 Replacement Volume and 2015 Supplement)

13 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
14 Article – Transportation  
15 Section 5–201.1(c)(1), 6–201.1(b)(1), and 7–202(a)  
16 Annotated Code of Maryland  
17 (2015 Replacement Volume and 2015 Supplement)

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### Article – Transportation

20 5–201.

21 (a) There is a Maryland Aviation Commission.

2 (c) The Chairman of the Commission shall:

3 (1) Based on the advice of the Commission, and subject to the approval of  
4 the Governor **AND WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE**, appoint the  
5 Executive Director of the Administration in accordance with § 5-501 of the General  
6 Provisions Article; and

7 5-202.

8 There is a Maryland Aviation Administration in the Department.

9 6-201.

10 (a) There is a Maryland Port Commission.

11 6-201.1.

12 (b) The Chairman of the Commission shall:

13 (1) Subject to the approval of the Governor **AND WITH THE ADVICE AND**  
14 **CONSENT OF THE SENATE**, appoint the Executive Director of the Administration in  
15 accordance with § 5-501 of the General Provisions Article; and

16 6-202.

17 There is a Maryland Port Administration.

18 7-201.

19 There is a Maryland Transit Administration in the Department.

20 7-202.

21 (a) The head of the Administration is the Maryland Transit Administrator, who  
22 shall be appointed by the Secretary with the approval of the Governor **AND WITH THE**  
23 **ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE**.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
25 October 1, 2016.
