

Chapter 414

(House Bill 1017)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws – Registration and Driver’s License Renewal Fees – No Charge for Recipients of Medal of Honor

FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Motor Vehicle Administration from charging a recipient of the Medal of Honor a fee for the renewal of the registration of a vehicle owned by the Medal of Honor recipient or for the renewal of the Medal of Honor recipient’s noncommercial driver’s license; and generally relating to vehicle registration and driver’s license renewal fees.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Transportation

THE ADMINISTRATION MAY NOT CHARGE A RECIPIENT OF THE MEDAL OF HONOR A FEE FOR THE RENEWAL OF THE REGISTRATION OF A VEHICLE OWNED BY THE MEDAL OF HONOR RECIPIENT.

(b) (1) [For] **EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, FOR** the renewal of a noncommercial Class A, B, C, D, E, or M driver’s license, a licensee shall pay the Administration a renewal fee established by the Administration.

(2) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY NOT CHARGE A LICENSEE WHO IS A RECIPIENT OF THE MEDAL OF HONOR A FEE FOR THE RENEWAL OF THE LICENSEE'S NONCOMMERCIAL CLASS A, B, C, D, E, OR M DRIVER'S LICENSE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2011.
