A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Real Property – Actions for Possession – Pet Protections

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Agriculture to develop, publish, and 4 regularly update a fact sheet on the care and protection of pets in the event of an $\mathbf{5}$ eviction or any other loss of possession of real property; requiring the fact sheet to be 6 published in a certain manner; requiring a landlord to provide information about the 7 fact sheet at the execution of a lease under certain circumstances; requiring the 8 Maryland Judiciary to provide information about the fact sheet when issuing certain 9 warrants; requiring a sheriff, a constable, or any other official, under certain 10 circumstances, to return a pet to a tenant or certain other person or to contact an 11 animal shelter or a rescue organization and provide certain notice; prohibiting the 12leaving of a pet on public property; and generally relating to actions for possession 13 of real property and pet protections.

3 (1) A LANDLORD AGAINST A TENANT UNDER § 8–401, § 8–402, OR § 4 8–402.1 OF THIS ARTICLE; OR

5 (2) A COMPLAINANT AGAINST A PERSON HOLDING POSSESSION OF 6 REAL PROPERTY UNDER § 14–132 OF THIS TITLE.

8 (A) BY OCTOBER 1, 2023, THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE SHALL 9 DEVELOP AND PUBLISH ON ITS WEBSITE A FACT SHEET THAT PROVIDES 10 INFORMATION ABOUT HOW A PERSON MAY CARE FOR AND PROTECT ANY PETS IN 11 THE EVENT THE PERSON IS EVICTED OR LOSES POSSESSION OF THE PERSON'S 12 PROPERTY.

13 (B) THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE SHALL:

14 (1) INCLUDE IN THE FACT SHEET INFORMATION ON STATE AND 15 LOCAL RESOURCES, INCLUDING ANIMAL SHELTERS AND ANIMAL RESCUE 16 ORGANIZATIONS; AND

17 (2) UPDATE THE FACT SHEET ON A REGULAR BASIS.

19 ON OR AFTER NOVEMBER 1, 2023, AT THE EXECUTION OF A LEASE, THE 20 LANDLORD SHALL INCLUDE WITH THE LEASE A DESCRIPTION OF THE FACT SHEET 21 PUBLISHED UNDER § 14–803 OF THIS SUBTITLE AND WHERE THE FACT SHEET IS 22 LOCATED ON THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE'S WEBSITE IF THE LANDLORD 23 KNOWS THAT A TENANT POSSESSES A PET.

BEGINNING NOVEMBER 1, 2023, THE MARYLAND JUDICIARY SHALL INCLUDE A DESCRIPTION OF THE FACT SHEET PUBLISHED UNDER § 14–803 OF THIS SUBTITLE AND WHERE THE FACT SHEET IS LOCATED ON THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE'S WEBSITE WITH ANY WARRANT ISSUED UNDER § 8–401(F)(1)(I), § 8–402(B)(2)(I) OR (V), OR § 8–402.1(B) OF THIS ARTICLE OR § 14–132(F) OR (I) OF THIS TITLE.

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1 (A) (1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, WHEN 2 POSSESSION OF REAL PROPERTY IS DELIVERED TO A LANDLORD OR COMPLAINANT 3 FOLLOWING AN ACTION UNDER § 8–401, § 8–402, OR § 8–402.1 OF THIS ARTICLE OR 4 § 14–132 OF THIS TITLE, THE SHERIFF, CONSTABLE, OR OTHER OFFICIAL SHALL:

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(I) IMMEDIATELY INSPECT THE PREMISES FOR ANY PET; AND

6 (II) PROVIDE TO THE TENANT OR PERSON WHO WAS HOLDING 7 POSSESSION OF THE REAL PROPERTY ANY PET ON THE PREMISES BELONGING TO 8 THE TENANT OR PERSON WHO WAS HOLDING POSSESSION OF THE REAL PROPERTY.

9 (2) IF THE TENANT OR PERSON WHO WAS HOLDING POSSESSION OF 10 REAL PROPERTY IS NOT PRESENT AT THE TIME THE REAL PROPERTY IS DELIVERED 11 TO A LANDLORD OR COMPLAINANT, THE SHERIFF, CONSTABLE, OR OTHER OFFICIAL 12 SHALL:

13(I)CONTACT AN ANIMAL SHELTER OR ANIMAL RESCUE14ORGANIZATION TO TAKE CUSTODY OF THE PET;

(II) PROVIDE THE TENANT OR PERSON WHO WAS HOLDING
POSSESSION OF THE REAL PROPERTY WITH THE NAME AND CONTACT INFORMATION
OF THE ANIMAL SHELTER OR ANIMAL RESCUE ORGANIZATION WHERE THE PET IS
TAKEN; AND

(III) PROVIDE THE ANIMAL SHELTER OR ANIMAL RESCUE
ORGANIZATION WITH THE NAME AND CONTACT INFORMATION, INCLUDING THE
TELEPHONE NUMBER IF AVAILABLE, OF THE TENANT OR PERSON WHO WAS
HOLDING POSSESSION OF THE REAL PROPERTY FROM WHICH THE PET WAS TAKEN.

(B) A PERSON MAY NOT REMOVE A PET FROM REAL PROPERTY DELIVERED
TO A LANDLORD OR COMPLAINANT FOLLOWING AN ACTION UNDER § 8–401, § 8–402,
OR § 8–402.1 OF THIS ARTICLE OR § 14–132 OF THIS TITLE AND LEAVE THE PET ON
PUBLIC PROPERTY OR A PUBLIC RIGHT–OF–WAY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June
 1, 2023.

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
