Baltimore County - Speed Monitoring Systems - Days and Times of Operation, Minimum Excess Speed, and Penalties

FOR the purpose of altering the restriction on the days and times during which a speed 4 5 monitoring system in a school zone may operate in Baltimore County; decreasing the 6 minimum number of miles per hour above a posted speed limit that a motor vehicle 7 must be traveling in Baltimore County in order for the motor vehicle to be recorded 8 by a speed monitoring system; increasing the maximum civil penalty for a violation 9 recorded by a speed monitoring system in Baltimore County; establishing that a person in Baltimore County may elect to perform a certain number of hours of 10 11 community service rather than pay a civil penalty for a violation recorded by a speed 12 monitoring system; requiring that a citation issued in Baltimore County for a 13 violation recorded by a speed monitoring system contain certain information on performance and reporting of community service completed under this Act; altering 14 15 a certain definition; and generally relating to speed monitoring systems.

- 21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 22 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 1 (a) (8) "Speed monitoring system" means a device with one or more motor 2 vehicle sensors producing recorded images of motor vehicles traveling at speeds [at least 3 12 miles per hour] above the posted speed limit.
- 4 (b) (1) (viii) **1.** A speed monitoring system in a school zone may operate only Monday through Friday between 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.
- 2. IN BALTIMORE COUNTY, A SPEED MONITORING
 7 SYSTEM IN A SCHOOL ZONE MAY OPERATE ONLY MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY
 8 BETWEEN 6:00 A.M. AND 10:00 P.M. AND SATURDAY AND SUNDAY BETWEEN 8:00 A.M.
 9 AND 6:00 P.M.
- 10 (c) (1) [Unless] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS
 11 SUBSECTION, UNLESS the driver of the motor vehicle received a citation from a police
 12 officer at the time of the violation, the owner or, in accordance with subsection (f)(4) of this
 13 section, the driver of a motor vehicle is subject to a civil penalty if the motor vehicle is
 14 recorded by a speed monitoring system [while being operated in violation of this subtitle]:
- 15 (I) WHILE TRAVELING AT SPEEDS AT LEAST 12 MILES PER 16 HOUR ABOVE THE POSTED SPEED LIMIT; OR
- 17 (II) IN BALTIMORE COUNTY, WHILE TRAVELING AT SPEEDS AT 18 LEAST 8 MILES PER HOUR ABOVE THE POSTED SPEED LIMIT.
- 19 (2) (I) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS 20 PARAGRAPH, A civil penalty under this subsection may not exceed \$40.
- 21 (II) IN BALTIMORE COUNTY, A CIVIL PENALTY UNDER THIS 22 SUBSECTION MAY NOT EXCEED \$50.
- 23 (3) IN BALTIMORE COUNTY, A PERSON WHO IS SUBJECT TO A CIVIL PENALTY UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MAY CHOOSE TO PERFORM 5 HOURS OF COMMUNITY SERVICE INSTEAD OF PAYING THE CIVIL PENALTY.
- 26 (4) For purposes of this section, the District Court shall prescribe:
- 27 (i) A uniform citation form consistent with subsection (d)(1) of this section and § 7–302 of the Courts Article; and
- 29 (ii) A civil penalty, which shall be indicated on the citation, to be paid 30 by persons who choose to prepay the civil penalty without appearing in District Court.
