A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2006 – Anne Arundel County –**
3 **Hancock’s Resolution Visitor Center**

4 FOR the purpose of amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2006
5 to provide that a certain grant for the Hancock’s Resolution Visitor Center may
6 not terminate before a certain date; and generally relating to amending the
7 Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2006.

9 Chapter 46 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2006, as amended by Chapter

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

18 (O) Hancock’s Resolution Visitor Center. Provide a grant equal to
19 the lesser of (i) \$100,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching
20 fund provided, to the County Executive and County Council of
21 Anne Arundel County for the planning and design of a new
22 visitor center at Hancock’s Resolution, including related site
23 work, located in Pasadena, subject to a requirement that the
24 grantee grant and convey a historic easement to the Maryland
