## Natural Resources - Oyster Poaching - Administrative Penalties

- 3 FOR the purpose of repealing the offense for taking ovsters with gear that is prohibited in 4 a certain area; establishing an offense for taking oysters with a power dredge in a certain area; altering the administrative penalties that apply to a person for 5 knowingly committing certain offenses related to oyster poaching by authorizing 6 7 requiring the Department of Natural Resources under certain circumstances to 8 suspend the person's oyster license for a first offense certain time period if the person 9 has not been convicted of a certain violation within a certain time period; clarifying that any one of certain oyster poaching offenses qualifies as a second or subsequent 10 offense for certain purposes under certain circumstances grounds for suspension of 11 an oyster license; and generally relating to administrative penalties for oyster 12 13 poaching.

- 1 2 4-1210.3 (a) (1) In addition to any other penalty or fine provided in this title, a person 4 who holds a license to catch oysters under § 4–701 of this title and receives a citation for an offense listed under paragraph (2) of this subsection may have the license SUSPENDED OR 5 revoked in accordance with this section. 6 7 The following offenses, committed in violation of this title or of any 8 regulation adopted under this title, are grounds for SUSPENSION OR revocation of a license to catch oysters under this section: 9 10 (i) Taking oysters located more than 200 feet within a closed or 11 prohibited area: 12 (ii) Taking oysters with gear that is prohibited in that area A POWER 13 DREDGE IN AN AREA RESERVED FOR ANOTHER TYPE OF GEAR: 14 (iii) Taking oysters outside of a time restriction for the harvest of oysters by more than 1 hour; 15 16 Taking oysters during closed seasons; and (iv) 17 Taking oysters from a leased area by a person other than the (v) leaseholder or the leaseholder's designee. 18 19 (b) Within 60 days after a person who holds a license to catch oysters under 20 § 4-701 of this title receives a citation for an offense listed under subsection (a) of this 21section, the Department shall hold a hearing on the matter in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act under Title 10, Subtitle 2 of the State Government Article. 2223After a hearing is conducted under paragraph (1) of this subsection, if 24the presiding officer finds or concludes that the person knowingly has committed [an] ANY offense listed under subsection (a)(2) of this section, the Department SHALL: 25 26 FOR A FIRST OFFENSE, MAY SUSPEND THE PERSON'S <del>(I)</del> 27 LICENSE TO CATCH OYSTERS: AND 28 <del>(II)</del> FOR A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE THAT ARISES OUT OF A SEPARATE SET OF CIRCUMSTANCES, shall revoke the person's license to catch 29 30 ovsters.

3 4 5	2. <u>If the presiding officer finds or concludes</u> THAT THE VIOLATION IS AN EGREGIOUS VIOLATION, REVOKE THE PERSON'S LICENSE TO CATCH OYSTERS; OR
6 7	(II) FOR ANY OTHER OFFENSE, REVOKE THE PERSON'S LICENSE TO CATCH OYSTERS.
8 9 10	(c) A person who is aggrieved by the final decision of the Department may obtain judicial review of the decision in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act under Title 10, Subtitle 2 of the State Government Article.
11 12 13	(d) A person whose license has been <b>SUSPENDED OR</b> revoked in accordance with this section may not engage or work in the fishery for which the license was <b>SUSPENDED OR</b> revoked whether or not it requires the use of another license.
