BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Public Safety 12–206. (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

 20 TOTAL SQUARE FOOTAGE OF THE PROPERTY; OR
- 21 (3) A NATURAL GAS OR LIQUEFIED PROPANE PIPING SYSTEM THAT 22 REQUIRES THE ADDITION OF A NEW GAS LINE TO THE GAS PIPING SYSTEM.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or application to any new construction for which a building permit is issued before the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2022.
