BY adding to Article - Commercial Law Section 14–3203 Annotated Code of Maryland (2013 Replacement Volume and 2020 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 3 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 4 INDICATED.
- 5 (2) (1) "AUTOMATIC DIALER" MEANS EQUIPMENT OR SOFTWARE
 6 THAT MAKES A SERIES OF CALLS TO STORED TELEPHONE NUMBERS, INCLUDING
 7 NUMBERS STORED ON A LIST.
- 8 (H) "AUTOMATIC DIALER" DOES NOT INCLUDE EQUIPMENT
 9 THAT REQUIRES A HUMAN TO DIAL OR PLACE EACH INDIVIDUAL CALL ONE CALL AT
 10 A TIME, AND REQUIRES THE HUMAN TO THEN REMAIN ON EACH CALL "AUTOMATIC
 11 TELEPHONE DIALING SYSTEM" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN 47 U.S.C § 227.
- 12 (3) "OFFICE" MEANS THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.

- 17 (II) AN ARTIFICIAL OR PRERECORDED VOICE.
- 18 (B) THE OFFICE OF ATTORNEY GENERAL SHALL:
- 19 (1) MAINTAIN A WEBSITE WHERE A CONSUMER IS ABLE TO REPORT 20 ROBOCALLS AND OTHER SPAM CALLS; AND
- 21 **(2)** PROVIDE NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC THROUGH PRINT, RADIO, OR
 22 TELEVISION ADVERTISEMENTS INFORMING ESTABLISH AND PROMOTE AN
 23 EDUCATION CAMPAIGN THAT INFORMS CONSUMERS ON HOW TO:
- 24 (I) IDENTIFY ROBOCALLS AND OTHER TYPES OF SPAM CALLS; 25 AND
- 26 (II) REPORT ROBOCALLS AND OTHER SPAM CALLS TO THE 27 OFFICE.
- 28 (C) THE OFFICE SHALL NOTIFY THE FEDERAL TRADE COMMISSION OF 29 EACH REPORT IT RECEIVES THROUGH THE WEBSITE REGARDING A ROBOCALL OR 30 OTHER SPAM CALL.

8 9	(4) THE DEMOGRAPHIC INFORMATION OF EACH CONSUMER WHO MAKES A REPORT;
10 11	(5) THE GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION OF EACH CONSUMER WHO MAKES A REPORT; AND
12 13	(6) ANY OTHER INFORMATION THE OFFICE BELIEVES IS RELEVANT TO CONSUMER PROTECTION AND ROBOCALLS AND OTHER SPAM CALLS.
