 terms; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to
 nondisclosure agreements.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article Labor and Employment
- 17 **3–714.**
- 18 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 19 INDICATED.
- 20 (2) "EMPLOYER" MEANS A PERSON ENGAGED IN A BUSINESS, AN 21 INDUSTRY, A PROFESSION, A TRADE, OR ANY OTHER ENTERPRISE IN THE STATE.

HOUSE BILL 1066

1(3) "NONDISCLOSURE AGREEMENT" MEANS AN ORAL OR A WRITTEN2AGREEMENT BETWEEN AN EMPLOYER AND AN EMPLOYEE THAT PROHIBITS AN3EMPLOYEE FROM DISCLOSING PROPRIETARY INFORMATION TO A THIRD PARTY.

4 (B) AN EMPLOYER MAY NOT:

5 (1) INCLUDE A NONDISCLOSURE AGREEMENT IN AN EMPLOYMENT 6 CONTRACT OR ANY OTHER SIMILAR EMPLOYMENT-RELATED DOCUMENTS;

7 (2) REQUIRE AN EMPLOYEE TO ENTER INTO A NONDISCLOSURE 8 AGREEMENT WITH THE EMPLOYER FOR ANY REASON; OR

9 (3) OTHERWISE ESTABLISH WITH AN EMPLOYEE THE EXPECTATION 10 THAT A CONFIDENTIAL RELATIONSHIP EXISTS WITH RESPECT TO PROPRIETARY 11 INFORMATION.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That a presently existing obligation 13 or contract right may not be impaired in any way by this Act and that this Act shall be 14 construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any 15 effect on or application to any nondisclosure agreements in effect before the effective date 16 of this Act.

17 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 18 October 1, 2015.
