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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws – Stopping, Standing, and Parking – Plug-In Vehicles**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from stopping, standing, or parking a vehicle  
4 that is not a plug-in vehicle in a space that is marked for the use of plug-in  
5 vehicles and provides access to a plug-in vehicle recharging station; defining a  
6 certain term; and generally relating to a prohibition against stopping, standing,  
7 or parking nonplug-in vehicles in certain spaces.

9 Article – Transportation

10 Section 11-145.1 and 21-1003(ff)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Transportation**

16 **11-145.1.**

17 **“PLUG-IN VEHICLE” MEANS A MOTOR VEHICLE THAT:**

18 **(1) IS MADE BY A VEHICLE MANUFACTURER;**

19 **(2) IS MANUFACTURED PRIMARILY FOR USE ON PUBLIC STREETS,**  
20 **ROADS, AND HIGHWAYS;**

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EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1           **(3) HAS NOT BEEN MODIFIED FROM ORIGINAL MANUFACTURER**  
2 **SPECIFICATIONS;**

3           **(4) IS RATED AT NOT MORE THAN 8,500 POUNDS UNLOADED**  
4 **GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT;**

5           **(5) HAS A MAXIMUM SPEED CAPABILITY OF AT LEAST 65 MILES**  
6 **PER HOUR; AND**

7           **(6) IS PROPELLED TO A SIGNIFICANT EXTENT BY AN ELECTRIC**  
8 **MOTOR THAT DRAWS ELECTRICITY FROM A BATTERY THAT:**

9                   **(I) HAS A CAPACITY OF NOT LESS THAN 4**  
10 **KILOWATT-HOURS FOR 4-WHEELED MOTOR VEHICLES AND NOT LESS THAN 2.5**  
11 **KILOWATT-HOURS FOR 2-WHEELED OR 3-WHEELED MOTOR VEHICLES; AND**

12                   **(II) IS CAPABLE OF BEING RECHARGED FROM AN EXTERNAL**  
13 **SOURCE OF ELECTRICITY.**

14 21-1003.

15           **(FF) A PERSON MAY NOT STOP, STAND, OR PARK A VEHICLE THAT IS NOT**  
16 **A PLUG-IN VEHICLE IN A SPACE THAT:**

17                   **(1) IS MARKED FOR THE USE OF PLUG-IN VEHICLES; AND**

18                   **(2) PROVIDES ACCESS TO A PLUG-IN VEHICLE RECHARGING**  
19 **STATION.**

20           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
21 October 1, 2012.
