3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from willfully and knowingly taking certain 4 actions to attempt to cause another person to commit a felony or misdemeanor 5 violation of election law; providing that a person who violates a certain provision of 6 this Act is guilty of a felony and on conviction is subject to certain penalties; 7 providing that a person who violates a certain provision of this Act is guilty of a 8 misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to certain penalties; providing that it is 9 not a defense to a prosecution for a violation of this Act that the person allegedly solicited by the defendant could not be guilty of the crime solicited; and generally 10 11 relating to prohibiting solicitation to commit an election crime.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 3 (C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY
- 4 OF A FELONY AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN
- 5 \$10,000 OR IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 5 YEARS OR BOTH.
- 6 (D) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY
- 7 OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN
- 8 \$5,000 OR IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 3 YEARS OR BOTH.
- 9 (E) It is not a defense to a prosecution for a violation of this
- 10 SECTION THAT THE PERSON ALLEGEDLY SOLICITED BY THE DEFENDANT COULD NOT
- 11 BE GUILTY OF THE CRIME SOLICITED.
