A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Workgroup to Evaluate the Establishment of a Regional Waste Disposal Facility

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of the Environment to convene a workgroup to evaluate the establishment of a regional waste disposal facility to serve Anne 4 Arundel County, Baltimore City, Baltimore County, Carroll County, Harford 5 County, and Howard County; providing for the composition of the workgroup; 6 7 requiring the workgroup to report certain findings and recommendations to the Governor and the General Assembly on or before a certain date; and generally 8 9 relating to a workgroup to evaluate the establishment of a regional waste disposal 10 facility.
- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 12 That:
- 13 (a) The Department of the Environment shall convene a workgroup to evaluate 14 the establishment of a regional waste disposal facility to serve Anne Arundel County, 15 Baltimore City, Baltimore County, Carroll County, Harford County, and Howard County.
- 16 (b) The workgroup convened under subsection (a) of this section shall include:
- 17 (1) six representatives of local government, including one representative 18 each from Anne Arundel County, Baltimore City, Baltimore County, Carroll County, 19 Harford County, and Howard County;
- 20 (2) one representative of the recycling industry;
- 21 (3) one representative of the waste diversion industry;
- 22 (4) one representative of the Northeast Maryland Waste Disposal 23 Authority; and



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1	(5)	one re	epresentative of the Maryland Environmental Service.
2 3 4	(c) (1) On or before December 1, 2022, the workgroup shall report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.		
5	(2)	The r	eport required under this subsection shall include proposals:
6		(i)	for the siting of a regional waste disposal facility;
7 8	disposal facility;	(ii)	for sharing costs associated with establishing a regional waste
9		(iii)	for developing service networks;
0		(iv)	that consider modern technology;
$\frac{1}{2}$	for disposal;	(v)	that consider consolidation needs, including common solutions
13		(vi)	that provide a commitment to phase out incineration;
4		(vii)	that focus on recycling, reuse, and composting; and
5		(viii)	that advance principles of zero waste.
