1 AN ACT concerning

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State Board of Waterworks and Waste Systems Operators – Fee Setting, Sunset Extension, and Program Evaluation

- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Board of Waterworks and Waste Systems Operators 5 to set certain fees so as to produce funds sufficient to cover certain costs of regulating 6 waterworks, wastewater works, and industrial wastewater works in accordance with 7 certain provisions of law; continuing the Board in accordance with the Maryland Program Evaluation Act (sunset law) by extending to a certain date the termination 8 9 provisions relating to statutory and regulatory authority of the Board; requiring that 10 an evaluation of the Board and the statutes and regulations that relate to the Board 11 be performed on or before a certain date; and generally relating to the State Board 12 of Waterworks and Waste Systems Operators.
