6 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to ensure that the driver's 7 license, identification card, or registration plate of an applicant who indicates on an application for a driver's license, an identification card, or a vehicle registration that 8 the applicant is on the autism spectrum includes a notation specifying that the 9 10 applicant is on the autism spectrum; requiring an application for a driver's license. 11 an identification card, or a vehicle registration to allow an applicant to indicate that the applicant is on the autism spectrum; requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration 12 to create a voluntary developmental disability self-disclosure envelope; and 13 generally relating to driver's licenses, identification cards, and registration plates of 14 individuals on the autism spectrum developmental disability self-disclosure 15 16 envelopes.
