- FOR the purpose of increasing the number of members of the State Board for Professional Engineers; requiring a certain number of one of the engineer members of the Board to be on appointed, without regard to specific professional practice, from a certain list submitted by the Maryland Society of Professional Engineers; requiring a certain list to include only individuals who practice certain engineering specialties; making certain conforming changes; specifying the terms of the new members of the Board; and generally relating to the State

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

6 7	(3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
