A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning 2 Vehicle Laws - Off-Highway Recreational Vehicles 3 FOR the purpose of altering the definition of "off-highway recreational vehicle" as it applies to the Maryland Vehicle Law to include a side-by-side utility vehicle; altering the 4 5 fee for a certificate of title for an off-highway recreational vehicle; and generally 6 relating to off-highway recreational vehicles. 7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, 8 Article – Transportation 9 Section 11-140.1 and 13-802 10 Annotated Code of Maryland 11 (2012 Replacement Volume and 2016 Supplement) 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 13 14 **Article – Transportation** 15 11-140.1. "Off-highway recreational vehicle" means a vehicle that is: 16 (a) A motor-assisted or motor-driven vehicle that: 17 (1) 18 Is designed to carry only the operator of the vehicle on a seat or saddle designed to be straddled by the operator or is designed to carry only the operator of 19 the vehicle and one passenger; and 20 21 Is commonly known as an all-terrain vehicle; (ii)

- 2 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section and § 13–805 of this subtitle, the fee for each certificate of title issued under this title is \$100.
- 4 (b) (1) The fee for each certificate of title issued for a rental vehicle is \$50.
- 5 (2) THE FEE FOR EACH CERTIFICATE OF TITLE ISSUED FOR AN 6 OFF-HIGHWAY RECREATIONAL VEHICLE IS \$35.
- 7 **(3)** The fee for each certificate of title issued for a motor scooter or a moped 8 is \$20.
- 9 [(3)] (4) On the death of a joint owner of a vehicle, the Administration may not charge a fee for a new certificate of title issued for the vehicle to another joint owner who is the surviving spouse.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 October 1, 2017.
