1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Pharmacy Benefits – Processing and Adjudication of Claims –**
3 **Restrictions on Fees**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting pharmacy benefits managers or certain purchasers from
5 directly or indirectly charging a contracted pharmacy, or holding a contracted
6 pharmacy responsible for, certain fees; defining a certain term; and generally
7 relating to pharmacy benefits, fees, and the processing and adjudication of claims.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Insurance**

16 **15–1628.2.**

17 **(A) IN THIS SECTION, “CONTRACTED PHARMACY” HAS THE MEANING**
18 **STATED IN § 15–1628.1 OF THIS PART.**

19 **(B) A PHARMACY BENEFITS MANAGER OR A PURCHASER MAY NOT**
20 **DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY CHARGE A CONTRACTED PHARMACY, OR HOLD A**
21 **CONTRACTED PHARMACY RESPONSIBLE FOR, A FEE RELATED TO A CLAIM THAT IS**

4 **ADJUDICATED CLAIM.**
