9 10	(4) "HANDWASHING SINK" MEANS A SINK USED FOR HANDWASHING ONLY.
11 12	(5) (I) "THREE-COMPARTMENT BAR SANITATION SINK" MEANS A THREE-COMPARTMENT SINK USED ONLY FOR WASHING BARWARE AND BAR TOOLS.
13 14	(II) "THREE-COMPARTMENT BAR SANITATION SINK" DOES NOT INCLUDE A SINK USED FOR:

19 20	(B) A GRAYWATER SYSTEM MAY BE USED TO SERVE A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE BUILDING THAT:
