WHEREAS, Plastic bags, plastic bottles, and plastic straws are a significant sourceof pollution; and

19 WHEREAS, Innovation should take precedence over banning plastics; and

WHEREAS, The United States has never encountered a problem that it could not solve through innovation, science, and technology; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

| (1) THE WINNER OF THE BIODEGRADABLE BAG COMPETITION SHALL BE AWARDED \$1,000,000; |
| (2) THE WINNER OF THE BIODEGRADABLE BOTTLE COMPETITION SHALL BE AWARDED \$1,000,000; AND |
| (3) THE WINNER OF THE BIODEGRADABLE STRAW COMPETITION SHALL BE AWARDED \$1,000,000. |
| SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2023. |
