| 10 11 | SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: |
| 12 | Article – Tax – General |
| 13 | 9–305. |
| 14 | (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, the motor fuel tax rate is: |
| 15 | (1) 7 cents for each gallon of aviation gasoline; |
| 16 | (2) 23.5 cents for each gallon of gasoline other than aviation gasoline; |
| $17\\18$ | (3) 24.25 cents for each gallon of special fuel other than clean-burning fuel or turbine fuel; |
| 19 | (4) 7 cents for each gallon of turbine fuel; and |
| 20 21 | (5) 23.5 cents for each gasoline–equivalent gallon of clean–burning fuel except electricity. |

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1 (b) The motor fuel tax rates specified in subsection (a)(2), (3), and (5) of this (1) $\mathbf{2}$ section shall be increased on July 1, 2013, and July 1 of each subsequent year in accordance 3 with this subsection. 4 (2)On or before June 1 of each year, the Comptroller shall determine and $\mathbf{5}$ announce: 6 the growth in the Consumer Price Index for all urban consumers (i) 7 as determined by the Comptroller under paragraph (3) of this subsection; and 8 (ii) the motor fuel tax rates effective for the fiscal year beginning on 9 the following July 1 as determined by the Comptroller under paragraph (4) of this 10 subsection. In this paragraph, "Consumer Price Index for all urban 11 (3)(i) 12consumers" means the index published monthly by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the 13U.S. Department of Labor that is the U.S. city average of all items in a basket of consumer 14goods and services. The percentage growth in the Consumer Price Index for all urban 15(ii) 16consumers shall be determined by comparing the average of the index for the 12 months ending on the preceding April 30 to the average of the index for the prior 12 months. 1718 Subject to paragraph (5) of this subsection, on July 1 of each year, each (4) 19 motor fuel tax rate specified in subsection (a)(2), (3), and (5) of this section shall be 20increased by the amount, rounded to the nearest one-tenth of a cent, that equals the product of multiplying: 2122(i) the motor fuel tax rate in effect on the date of the Comptroller's 23announcement under paragraph (2) of this subsection; and 24(ii) the percentage growth in the Consumer Price Index for all urban 25consumers. 26(5)(i) If there is a decline or no growth in the Consumer Price Index for 27all urban consumers, the motor fuel tax rates shall remain unchanged. 28Any increase in the motor fuel tax rates under paragraph (4) of (ii) 29this subsection may not be greater than 8% of the motor fuel tax rate effective in the 30 previous year. 31 (6)The Comptroller shall require any person possessing tax-paid motor 32fuel for sale at the start of business on the date of an increase in the motor fuel tax under 33 this subsection to compile and file an inventory of the motor fuel held at the close of business on the immediately preceding date and remit within 30 days any additional motor 34

35 fuel tax that is due on the motor fuel.

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1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

2 (a) Notwithstanding § 9–305(b) of the Tax – General Article, the motor fuel tax 3 rates in effect on July 1, 2021, under § 9–305(a)(2), (3), and (5) of the Tax – General Article 4 shall remain unchanged until the end of June 30, 2024.

5 (b) On July 1, 2024, and July 1 of each subsequent year, the motor fuel tax rates 6 under § 9–305(a)(2), (3), and (5) of the Tax – General Article in effect during the preceding 7 3 years under subsection (a) of this section shall be adjusted in accordance with § 9–305(b) 8 of the Tax – General Article.

9 (c) On or before June 1, 2024, and June 1 of each subsequent year, the 10 Comptroller shall make the determination and announcement required under § 9–305(b)(2) 11 of the Tax – General Article.

12 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency 13 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has 14 been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to 15 each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is 16 enacted.
