8 (c) (1) "Excessive force" means the use of greater physical force than 9 reasonably necessary to repel an attacker or terminate resistance.

10 (2) "Excessive force" does not include force that is reasonably necessary to 11 effect a lawful purpose.

12 (d) "False arrest" means an arrest made without legal justification.

13 (e) "False imprisonment" means the intentional restriction without legal 14 justification of the freedom of movement of a person who is aware of the restriction and 15 who does not consent.

- 17 **[**(1) repeated, unwarranted verbal or physical annoyances; or
- 18 (2) unwarranted threats or unwarranted demands]
