- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing a beer, wine, and liquor tasting license in Cecil County; 4 authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Cecil County to issue the beer, 5 wine, and liquor tasting license to a certain license holder; authorizing the license 6 holder to allow on-premises consumption of beer, wine, and liquor for tasting; 7 specifying the term of the license; requiring a license holder to provide certain notice 8 before exercising certain privileges; specifying the amount of beer, wine, and liquor 9 that an individual may sample at each offering; specifying certain license fees; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Cecil County. 10

\$400 FOR A 1-YEAR LICENSE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2017.
