A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Anne Arundel County – Assistant to the Sheriff – Appointment**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Sheriff of Anne Arundel County to appoint an
4 administrative or executive assistant to serve at the pleasure of the Sheriff;
5 exempting the administrative or executive assistant to the Sheriff from a
6 requirement that employees in the Sheriff's Office be in the county merit system;
7 and generally relating to appointed employees of the Sheriff of Anne Arundel County.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

16 2–309.

17 (c) (2) (i) The Sheriff of Anne Arundel County shall appoint deputies at a
18 salary as provided by the County Council.

19 (ii) The Sheriff may appoint a chief deputy who shall serve at the
20 pleasure of the Sheriff.

21 **(III) THE SHERIFF MAY APPOINT AN ADMINISTRATIVE**
22 **ASSISTANT OR EXECUTIVE ASSISTANT TO THE SHERIFF WHO SHALL SERVE AT THE**
23 **PLEASURE OF THE SHERIFF.**

1 (3) [Employees] **EXCEPT FOR AN EMPLOYEE APPOINTED UNDER**
2 **PARAGRAPH (2)(III) OF THIS SUBSECTION, EMPLOYEES** in the Sheriff's Office shall be
3 in the county merit system.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
5 October 1, 2015.
